What have we been doing?

Oak Class have visited Delamere forest to practise their map reading skills using 6 figure grid references. They used these to plan a route to various landmarks and then had to find their way back to the centre using their skills.

Children in **Acorn Preschool** have been learning about balancing objects in the outdoor provision this week. They have been recording their predictions and comparing objects.

Little Acorns have been learning about sea creatures and have been finding them in lots of areas of the classroom.
